FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT

With the warmer weather the last few weeks the maintenance staff are excited to get out on the course and start preparing for another great season. This offseason was very busy here as we took on a bunker renovation project and the removal of hazardous ash trees. We are very excited about the progress of our bunker renovation project. The Golf Shape crew is in the final stages of the project as they have begun cleaning up the edges, checking sand depths and will start raking and grooming the bunkers to a finished product. At the moment, the new drainage in the bunkers seems to be working wonderfully, which will greatly enhance the maintenance and playability. Lastly, we will install new drainage in a few approach areas which will help keep these areas firmer for players and hopefully lower your scores!

Our crew was busy throughout February working with a local arborist in identifying and removing hazardous ash trees around the property. This ongoing project aims to ensure the safety of our members and guests while preserving the natural beauty of our surroundings. Over the winter, selected ash trees were removed, with plans in place to continue this initiative over the next several winters. As part of our commitment to sustainability, we will be replanting new trees in the areas where removals have taken place, ensuring that our landscape remains vibrant and healthy for years to come.

The golf course itself has wintered very well, thanks to relatively little snow cover and warmer temperatures. This has allowed us to get a bit of a head start on the cleanup plus our other projects to be finished before the season starts. While the long-range forecast may not be as favourable as we have experienced in recent weeks, rest assured that we are working tirelessly to get the course open as soon as possible. With any luck, a warm and dry spring will soon have all of you back out on the course.

We are excited to showcase the new improvements to the course for the upcoming season. Not only are these investments into the club going to enhance the appearance and playability of the golf course, but it will also make the maintenance easier for our staff, which will allow us to direct time and attention to other aspects of the club.
