Summary information on Men's League Competitions

Putting Contest

What a great opportunity to improve your putting skill. This is a laddered match play competition played on the practice putting green. The winner moves along the ladder while the loser is eliminated.

Ringer Board

This is a full season competition (May 2 to Oct 3) utilizing your *best gross score for each hole*.

Any individual score during a Tuesday Men's League event will qualify for the Ringer Board and the committee will maintain and post the updated best gross scores on a weekly basis.

Singles Match Play

This is a laddered match play competition using 80 % of handicaps. The value of prizes will be determined by the number of participants.

Pairs Match Play

This is a laddered match play competition using 80 % of handicaps. You have the option of choosing your playing partner or have a partner assigned by the committee. The value of prizes will be determined by the number of participants.

Shark Shootout

This is a laddered match play competition using 80 % of handicaps. You have the option of choosing your playing partner or have a partner assigned by the committee. This unique competition involves 6 holes played as a Scramble, 6 holes as a Modified Alternate Shot and 6 holes as a Best Ball. The value of prizes will be determined by the number of participants.

Captain's Cup Day

This is a one-day team event with the winning team being awarded the Captain's Cup Trophy. Participants are placed into 3 or 4 flights based on handicap. Net scores are aggregated by flight to determine the winning team. Each team will tee off together with contiguous tee times.
